

## COMMON KDP TRIM SIZES

**Rule:** Choose your trim size **before** designing anything. Page size controls margins, aspect ratio, bleed, and image requirements.

### Most-Used KDP Trim Sizes (Quick Reference)

| TRIM SIZE | ASPECT RATIO | BEST FOR                  |
|-----------|--------------|---------------------------|
| 6 × 9     | 2:3          | Novels, journals, manuals |
| 5 × 8     | 5:8          | Compact novels            |
| 7 × 10    | 7:10         | Activity & kids' books    |
| 8 × 10    | 4:5          | Coloring & workbooks      |
| 8.5 × 11  | 17:22        | Planners, textbooks       |
| 8.5 × 8.5 | 1:1          | Square picture books      |

### Print-Ready Pixel Sizes (300 DPI)



| TRIM SIZE | PIXELS (W × H) |
|-----------|----------------|
| 6 × 9     | 1800 × 2700    |
| 5 × 8     | 1500 × 2400    |
| 7 × 10    | 2100 × 3000    |
| 8 × 10    | 2400 × 3000    |
| 8.5 × 11  | 2550 × 3300    |
| 8.5 × 8.5 | 2550 × 2550    |



## Image Generator Ratios (What to Pick)

When your tool asks for aspect ratio, choose:

| BOOK SIZE        | CHOOSE THIS RATIO |
|------------------|-------------------|
| $6 \times 9$     | 2:3               |
| $8 \times 10$    | 4:5               |
| $8.5 \times 8.5$ | 1:1               |
| $7 \times 10$    | 3:4 (close match) |
| $8.5 \times 11$  | 3:4 (close match) |
